When?

Key Ingredients

LIFT: Lactic (16%), Mandelic (8%), Pyruvic (4%) Acids Exfoliates and lifts existing visible hyperpigmentation while inhibiting melanin production.

PREVENT: Tranexamic Acid (TXA) (1%)

Pigment Correct Peel Protocol

Cleanse

1. Facial Wash Oily/Problem - Cleanse the area of treatment thoroughly. Rinse and pat dry.

Tone

2. Hydrating Toner - Apply with a cotton pad to prep (degrease) the skin. Allow the skin to dry.. Assess sensitivity by asking the patient, "On a scale of one to ten, ten being extremely active, how do you rate this sensation (or feeling)?"

Treat

3. Part 1 - Pore Refining Treatment - Dispense a 10p size amount, applying all over the face but avoiding application too close to the eye and lip area. Work in gentle circular motions then rinse and pat dry. PRO TIP- To make the treatment more bespoke for the patient choose the appropriate PCA Skin® Therapeutic Mask for your patient's skin or even multi mask.

Part 2 - Pigment Correct Peel - Gently agitate the product and apply four to five dots to a cotton pad, placing the neck of the bottle directly onto the pad, spacing it to give a sufficient working area to complete a full-face treatment (about four to five spots on the pad). This product may sting or tingle on some individuals. Assess patients sensitivity scale. If higher than a 6, do not apply a second layer. You can use a fan in between applications to dry the peel and cool the patient's skin. PCA Skin® peels are self neutralising and do not need timing or removing.

Hydrate & Protect

6. Apply a pea sized amount of ReBalance and Hydrator Plus Broad-Spectrum SPF product - Complete the treatment with this combination to calm, hydrate and protect the skin from UVA and UVB exposure.
